GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of July 23, 2010

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services. If legal or other requirements mean that you must buy any items that you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

A person who owns 50 percent or greater interest in this registered mortuary also owns 50 percent or greater interest in the following registered mortuaries in the State of New Jersey: Beth Israel Memorial Chapel, Highland Park, NJ and, Spotswood Funeral Home, Spotswood, NJ.

BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF \$1,525.00

Our fee for the basic services of the funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

1. Responding to the initial request for service
2. Conducting the arrangement conference
3. Preparation of biographical and statistical data
4. Examination of financial settlement options
5. Preparation and filing of necessary papers, permits and authorizations
6. Coordination with other service providers
7. Preparation and placement of the obituary notices
8. Retention and care of the remains prior to the commencement of post death activities

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING *(Including use of preparation room and sanitary care)*

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

If you choose to have an embalming performed, the decedent may be embalmed at a location other than this registered mortuary.

Please note that no human remains may remain unburied or uncremated in New Jersey for more than 48 hours unless embalmed or refrigerated as per N.J.A.C. 8:9-1.1.

* Including the removal of implanted devices, such as pacemakers, as required by the Crematory.

OTHER STAFF AND RELATED FACILITIES

- 1. Use of facilities, staff and equipment *for visitation/viewing.*

Our services include setup of the visitation area, placement of remains, positioning of the floral displays, and supervision and attendance during the hours of visitation.

- a. Private family viewing (per hour) \$295.00
- b. Visitation immediately prior to funeral (per hour) \$195.00
- c. One full day visitation or part thereof \$750.00

- 2. Use of facilities, staff and equipment *for funeral ceremony.*

Our services include coordinating the arrangements for the ceremony, staff supervision and attendance, and the use of the funeral home when used for the ceremony.

- a. At funeral home \$275.00
- b. At church or temple \$275.00
- c. At funeral home, to church or temple \$375.00

- 3. Use of facilities, staff and equipment *for memorial service*
(without the body present)

Our services include coordinating the arrangements for the memorial service, staff supervision and attendance, and the use of the funeral home for a 2 hour period when used for the memorial service.

- 4. Use of staff *for graveside service (whether at cemetery or crematory)*

Our services include supervision, attendance and accompaniment of the remains to the cemetery or crematory.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$2,985.00

This package charge includes the unassisted transfer of remains to this funeral home, basic services of the funeral director and staff, basic sheltering of remains, embalming, obtaining necessary permits and transfer of remains to Newark Liberty International Airport. It does not include a casket or alternative or shipping container, the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to the forwarding the remains, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include transferring the remains to another destination, or the charges of the common carrier, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$1,335.00

This package charge includes receiving the remains from the other funeral home via transfer of remains from Newark Liberty International Airport to our funeral home, basic sheltering of the remains, basic services of the funeral director and staff, the obtaining of all necessary permits and authorizations, and local (within 10 miles) transportation to the cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery’s charges for opening and closing of the grave, any required outer burial container or cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

DIRECT CREMATION

Our package charges for direct cremation include basic services of the funeral director and staff, the local (within 10 miles) unassisted transfer of remains to the funeral home, the basic sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, sanitary care and preparation of remains for identification and, local transportation to the crematory. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the cremation process, which is a crematory charge, or any other cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of corrugated material.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

Our package charges for immediate burial include basic services of the funeral director and staff, the local (within 10 miles) unassisted transfer of remains to this funeral home, the basic sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of all necessary permits and authorizations, and local transportation to the cemetery, sanitary care and preparation of the remains for identification. This charge does not include the use of the facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery’s charges for opening and closing of the grave, any required outer burial container or cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

- 1. Immediate burial with container provided by purchaser . . . \$2,225.00
- 2. Immediate burial with a casket selected from our funeral home (in addition to cost of the casket) \$2,225.00
- 3. Immediate burial with an alternative wood container . . . \$2,625.00

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ISRAEL \$4,850.00

This package charge includes the unassisted transfer of remains to this funeral home, basic services of the funeral director and staff, basic sheltering of remains, taharah (including facility fee), tachrichim, obtaining necessary permits, including consular documents, a Ziegler shipping container and outer air-tray and, transfer of remains to Newark or JFK International Airport. It also includes the use of facilities and staff for a funeral ceremony, prior to the forwarding the remains. It does not include the charges of the common carrier, the cemetery or funeral home in Israel or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers, and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.
